Upcoming public event

This will take place on:

Thursday 14 March 2024 4.30pm to 8pm North West Community Campus Alloway Road, Dumfries. DG2 9LU.

The event will be held in the atrium and will provide local residents with the chance to learn more about the proposals and speak to Wheatley Homes South and council staff.

This will give you the chance to ask questions and fill out feedback forms. Please note, comments should not be made directly to the council at this time. You will have the opportunity to make formal representations regarding the proposal when a planning application is submitted.

You said, we did

Listening to views from across the community has been central to our proposals and it is important everyone's voice is heard to help shape the regeneration proposals.

Listening to, and following up on, community issues raised by people living and working in Lochside is important to us.

At a recent focus group, customers advised there was a bollard missing, allowing people to access an area with vehicles, raising safety concerns. The bollard has now been replaced.

The Heras fencing has now been removed from our demolition sites and the ground has been seeded. The grass has now started to come through, making the open spaces more welcoming..

These are just some of the things that have happened following engagement with the local community over the future of Lochside.
