What's happened so far

We invited the community to have their say on the proposals, and we've contacted people at home, online, via text message and over the phone. A community-led local delivery group has been established to make key decisions and help shape the future of Lochside. Please get in touch if you would like to become involved and help us build a better brighter future. We've also held focus groups so people could tell us what they think face-to-face. We'd like to thank everyone who has taken the time to give us their views.

So far, we have had almost 800 responses from across the community to our initial Lochside regeneration survey.

Almost half of the people who responded told us the types of housing being built was their top priority. Other priorities

included tackling anti-social behaviour, more green space, improved transport links and street lighting.

Given how important the issue is, our first focus group looked at the types of housing needed across Lochside.

The event, held at the end of April, generated lots of interesting discussions around new and existing housing in Lochside and the types of homes people wanted to see to help meet the needs of the community.



What happens next?

We are continuing to talk to people in the community, listening to their views and making sure those views are at the heart of our plans for the regeneration.

We're holding more events, so as many people as possible can share their views. Here are some more dates for your diary.
